LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

- Graduated the 7th Class of the ULI Atlanta Center for Leadership (CFL) which builds relationships, common understanding of issues, and greater leadership capacity so that tomorrow's leaders will be better equipped to fulfill ULI's mission of leadership in the responsible use of land.
- Launched the local chapter of the ULI Women's Leadership Initiative.
- Hosted the 14th Annual national Hines Student Competition in Midtown Atlanta.
- Introduced 20 leaders in the industry to 20 young leaders through the Mentor Program.



EDUCATION & PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Hosted over 2,000 professionals at content-rich educational Programs and Events ranging from the Emerging Trends Conference to Learn-from-the-Best Breakfasts.
- 67 ULI members facilitated 167 high school and university students in Urban Plan, a program designed to develop a citizenry more educated about the challenges and complexities of land use decision.
- Held 4 sessions of the Capital Markets Council, facilitating two-way conversations between the real estate industry and the Sixth Federal Reserve District.
- Launched the Creative Development Council to advance context-sensitive, entrepreneurial development



TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

- 50 members of the Livable Communities Council (LCC) worked year-round on advancing walkable and transit-supported communities.
- Conducted 7 "mini" Technical Assistance Panels, bringing ULI member expertise to local non-profits and cities in the region.
- Conducted 2 Technical Assistance Panels – a retail strategy for Auburn Avenue and adaptive reuse strategy for the old Constitution Building in downtown Atlanta
